Application prerequisites	BACHELOR: Students need to have carried out either one or 2 years of higher education study in a corresponding design field before their mobility. The international class corresponds to the final year of a bachelor degree. MASTER: Students need to have completed a Bachelor degree to access our International Masters programs. Applications must be completed online.
