

## Overview English-taught Bachelor (BSc) courses for exchange students – Faculty of Science Fall semester 2022<sup>1</sup>

Bachelor students coming to the Faculty of Science to study for an exchange semester, can either choose from a selection of Electives (see availability below and in our online [Prospectus](#)), or from one of the minor programmes. These minors are a package of 30 EC, taught full-time, and cannot be combined with other courses. Places are limited and **students will be selected**. Only complete applications will be considered.

Master courses (level 500-600) are not open to bachelor students. Level 400 courses are only an option when they are part of a bachelor programme.

**Please note that the information in this document is based on the current course offer and is subject to change. The course offer for 22-23 will be finalized in the spring of 2022.**

### Selection of courses

Please read this information carefully, before selecting your courses in our online application portal. When you are applying for one of the minor programmes, make sure to select all separate courses from the specific minor (total of 30EC) during your application. Do not add other courses, as this is not possible next to a minor programme.

Different degree programmes at the Faculty of Science have overlapping schedules. When selecting courses at the Faculty of Science, we advise you *not* to choose courses from different degree programmes. You can see which degree programme a course belongs to by looking under 'Part of' in the [Prospectus](#) course description.

**Science courses have strict admission requirements. Make sure you meet these requirements before selecting a course. In your letter of motivation (see [required documents](#)) explain clearly why you believe you are qualified to follow your selected Science courses.**

### After selecting your courses

Your selected courses will be sent to the relevant course coordinators for approval.

After getting approval for a course, you are responsible for registering for the courses (instructions will be sent separately). Approval of courses in the exchange portal does not automatically mean registration for courses and exams. You have to do this yourself.

*Please note:* this is different from the other faculties! If you are also taking courses at another faculty of Leiden University, they will register you for those courses.
